








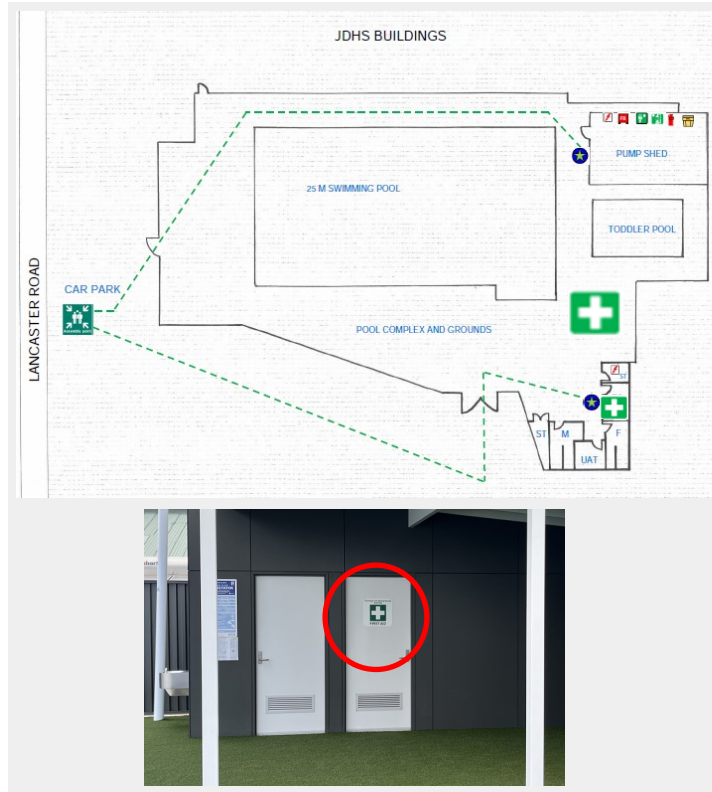

KEY HOLDER INFORMATION

The Shire of Jerramungup is pleased to welcome all community members to utilise the Swimming Pool for the 2023/2024 season with the pool opening for use from 11 September 2023.

As there is NO lifeguard on-duty at this facility, to ensure your safety under the Aquatic Facilities Code of Practice (Department of Health) the Shire requires all Key Holders to complete a Pool Induction Course which is valid for 3 years. Those wishing to attend a Pool Induction Course must register with the Shire and you will be placed on a list for the next available course. To register please email admin@jerramungup.wa.gov.au or call the Shire on 9835 1022. You will need to bring along your bathers as it is a requirement for you to demonstrate that you can swim the length of the pool (25 meters).

CONDITIONS OF USE

- DO NOT ENTER THE FACILITY IF SUFFERING FROM ANY SKIN PROBLEM, ILLNESS OR DISEASE THAT IS CONTAGIOUS. EXCEPTION (PROVIDE A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE - STATING NOT A RISK TO OTHER PATRONS)
- DO NOT ENTER THE WATER IF YOU HAVE DIARRHOEA OR HAD GASTROENTERITIS WITHIN THE LAST 14 DAYS
- CHILDREN UNDER 10 YEARS OF AGE MUST BE SUPERVISED BY A PERSON 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT ALL TIMES.
- CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 5 MUST BE WITHIN REACH OF THEIR CARER AT ALL TIMES.
- PARENTS OR GUARDIANS WITH CHILDREN UNDER 10 YEARS SHALL BE DRESSED TO ENTER THE WATER IF REQUIRED.
- PERSONS MUST NOT PERMIT ANIMALS UNDER THEIR CONTROL TO ENTER THE FACILITY. EXCEPTION (GUIDE-DOGS ETC, HOWEVER MUST NOT ENTER WATER)
- DO NOT ENTER WATER IF IN AN UNCLEAN CONDITION, OR WEARING UNCLEAN CLOTHES
- DO NOT ENTER WATER IF UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AND/OR DRUGS.
- BABIES, CHILDREN AND PERSON SUFFERING INCONTINENCE AND WHO ORDINARILY WEAR NAPPIES MUST WEAR AN AQUA-NAPPY WHEN IN THE WATERBODY.
- THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OR PERSONS PERMITTED IN THE POOL/SPA/WATERSLIDE AT ANY ONE TIME IS 107
- USE THE TOILET BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL
- DO NOT DEPOSIT RUBBISH, OR OFFENSIVE MATERIAL E.G. BODILY WASTES INTO THE WATER
- DO NOT ENTER WATER IF YOU HAVE ANY BLEEDING OR OOZING.
- NO DIVE-BOMBING, RUNNING OR ROUGH PLAY IN THE POOL.
- NO DISORDERLY BEHAVIOUR.
- NO ALCOHOL IN THE POOL AREA.
- NO SMOKING IN THE POOL AREA.
- NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED IN THE POOL AREA.
- NO GLASS OBJECTS TO BE TAKEN INTO THE POOL AREA.
- SURFBOARDS, BOOGIE BOARDS OR SIMILAR ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE POOL.
- ALL FLOATING TOYS AND OBJECTS ARE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE POOL AFTER USE.
- DO NOT USE SOAP, DETERGENT OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE IN THE WATER.
- REMOVE ALL RUBBISH FROM POOL AREA.
- DO NOT CLIMB UP, OR ONTO ANY FENCE OR PARTITION OR ROOF WITHIN THE POOL AREA.
