LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS 2023

Have you ever considered becoming a Shire Councillor? There is an election in October 2023, and four positions will be contested for a four year term on Council. If you are interested, nominations open on 31 August 2023 and close at 4.00pm on 7 September 2023.

WALGA, DLGSC and the WA Electoral Commission are hosting an Election Candidate Information Briefing Webinar on Monday, 14 August 2023, commencing at 6.00pm. Interested people should contact Glenda on 9835 1022 or email council@jerramungup.wa.gov.au for further information. You are invited to view the webinar at the Shire Office or on your own device.

Shire of Jerramungup elections are run by the Western Australian Electoral Commission, which appoints a Returning Officer for each election.

The voting method will be optional preferential voting—this is a new system and further information will be provided before the election.

Voting will be postal, as in recent Council elections.

WHO IS ENTITLED TO VOTE?

The roll for this election consists of:

- 1. Individuals who live in the Shire of Jerramungup and who are enrolled on the State Electoral Roll (the Residents Roll).
- 2. Non-resident owners or occupiers of rateable property in the Shire of Jerramungup (the Shire's Non-resident Owners and Occupiers Roll).

Residents Roll

Those residents who live in the Shire that are enrolled on the State Electoral Roll are automatically enrolled on the Residents Roll for local government elections.

Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers Roll

Owners of land or nominees of corporate bodies who own or occupy rateable property in the Shire, but are not enrolled on the State Electoral Roll for the Shire of Jerramungup, may apply to be on the Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers Roll.

You must be enrolled by 5.00pm, Friday, 25 August 2023 to be eligible to vote. For further information please contact the Shire Office.

COUNCIL MEETING MATTERS

Budget for 2023/2024

At the July 2023 Ordinary Council Meeting, Council adopted the Budget for the Financial Year 2023/2024.

The Budget was deliberated at length by Council and Staff to ensure that the Shire delivered a Budget that was both balanced and fair for our community in these increasingly challenging economic times, as the country continues to grapple with escalating costs.

Many families are having to manage rising living costs and unfortunately the Shire is not exempt from the increases to utilities, fuel, contractor supplies and materials, and many other goods and services.

The Council has worked hard to deliver a balanced Budget, which has resulted in approval of a 4.95% rate rise for this financial year.

Key Budget expenditure includes:

More than \$4.419 million committed to the renewal, upgrade, maintenance and expansion of our road and path network. The Shire's road network of roughly 1,200 kilometres continues to require significant financial commitment and management to ensure a reliable transportation network and safety for all users.

\$1.717 million has been allocated to commence the Bremer Bay Airfield Upgrade Project in 2023/2024, with the total project cost expected to be \$2.446 million over two financial years. The works will improve safety, capacity, capability, planning and security, as well as increasing regional access to health services in Bremer Bay.

\$1.691 million has been allocated to Recreation and Culture to provide services and facilities that support the social wellbeing of the community. This includes public halls, Jerramungup swimming pool, entertainment centre, sporting facilities, beaches, parks, gardens, playgrounds, walk trails, libraries, and other cultural activities.

\$1.637 million has been allocated to Community Amenities to provide rubbish collection and disposal services, litter control, stormwater drainage, environmental protection, public conveniences, cemeteries and planning for future community facilities.

\$1.233 million allocated to Law, Order and Public Safety will provide services to help ensure a safer community including emergency services, fire prevention, animal control and other law, order and public safety initiatives.

We look forward to delivering outstanding outcomes for the community and ensure the Shire is inclusive and sustainable.

VIC TEA TREE CONTROL PROGRAM

The Shire has been conducting weed control activities in Bremer Bay, with the key focus being on the removal of Vic Tea Tree populations from an area south of Garnett Road. These populations have the potential to impact on the ecological integrity of several bushland reserves that support significant native fauna populations, including threatened species such as Carnaby's Black Cockatoo, Western Pygmy Possum, Mallee Fowl, and numerous Reptiles.

The key objective is to reduce the Vic Tea Tree population from spreading into John Street Reserve and Gnombup Reserve.

Due to the potential spread of the viable seed the Vic Tea Tree is being mechanically controlled and stockpiled on site, then subjected to a controlled burn.
