Important Notes:

- 1. No Crossover shall be constructed without the issue of a Crossover Permit.
- 2. To receive a subsidy for a crossover, the completed application form and a plan showing the proposed location of the crossover must be lodged at least ten working days before work commences and the constructed crossover must meet the Shire of Jerramungup's minimum requirements.
- 3. No subsidy will be paid without Council receiving a receipt of payment for the crossover and a <u>completed</u> creditor form <u>detailing bank account details to where the subsidy is to be paid.</u>
- 4. Crossover subsidies are only paid to the landowner and only if no prior subsidy has been paid.
- 5. Under the Local Government Act 1995 the Shire of Jerramungup has the power to upgrade any non-compliant crossovers to the required standards at the applicant's expense.
- 6. If the crossover proposes to clear native vegetation:
 - a. The applicant must demonstrate that the site is chosen to minimise the clearing of native vegetation Or;
 - b. The applicant must provide approvals for the removal of significant flora.
- 7. The Permit is only valid for a period of twelve months from the date of issue.
- 8. Existing footpaths take precedence over new Crossovers but may require upgrading to specification.
- 9. By signing this application I <u>confirm agree</u>, that I have read and understood the Shire of Jerramungup's Crossover Guidelines and Specifications.
