- Danger** To you, others and casualty
- Response** is the person responsive?
- Send** Send someone to Call 000
- Airway** is the airway clear and open? Clear mouth and tilt head back.
- Breathing** Can you see, hear or feel casualty breathing normally? If not commence CPR
If breathing normally place in recovery position
- CPR** 30:2 Try to change rescuer every 2 minutes.
- Defibrillation** Attach an AED as soon as possible if available
AED attached follow voice prompts

Key Holder Information

The Shire of Jerramungup is pleased to welcome all community members to utilise the Swimming Pool for the 2019/20 season. The Pool will open for use from **MONDAY 1 of OCTOBER**

To ensure your safety, as there is NO lifeguard on-duty at this facility, under the Aquatic Facilities Code of Practice (Department of Health) the Shire require all **Key Holders** to complete a Pool Induction Course which is valid for 3 years.

Those wishing to attend the 2019/20 Pool Induction Courses must register with the Shire, you will be placed on a list for the next available course.

Please confirm your attendance via email admin@jerramungup.wa.gov.au or calling the Shire on 9835 1022.

You will need to bring along your bathers as you need to demonstrate that you can swim from one side to the other (12 metres)

Basic Pool Rules

- Drinking glasses and glass bottles are not permitted in the Pool Area.
 - Children under 16yrs must be accompanied by 1 adult (≥18yrs)
 - There may be no diving into the pool at the shallow end.
 - Smoking and the consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the pool area.
 - No dive bombing, running or rough play is allowed.
 - All toys and objects must be removed after each use.
 - Animals are not permitted in the Pool Area.
 - Guests pay the \$3 fee prior to entry into the Pool.
 - Please take consideration of all swimming.
- The Shire of Jerramungup and the Jerramungup Swimming Pool Management Committee reserve the right to eject anyone from the Pool Area and/or revoke User privileges for the remainder of the Season in circumstances where there has been a failure to observe any conditions of use or terms of this agreement.
