PRESCRIBED HAZARD REDUCTION ACTIVITY – BREMER BAY

Residents and visitors of Bremer Bay are advised that volunteers and staff from DFES, Bremer Bay VFES and the Shire of Jerramungup will be conducting Hazard Reduction Burns on Wellstead Road, Bremer Bay.

PURPOSE: To establish a low fuel buffer zone around the Bremer Bay town site to reduce the potential for a bushfire impacting the town site.

DATE: Wednesday 3 May 2023

LOCATION: Area along the west side of Wellstead Road



WHAT TO DO DURING AND AFTER HAZARD REDUCTION ACTIVITIES:

- Speed restrictions will be in place for the safety of Fire Fighters operating within the area with the possibility of local road closure on the day of the burn.
- Motorists are asked to have their headlights on when driving through the area and drive to the conditions as the smoke hazard will remain for a number of days after the burn is completed.
- Abide by all directions of Fire Fighters/Emergency Services personnel on scene.
- Smoke may affect visibility and air quality in and around Bremer Bay on the day itself and the days following. Residents and visitors with any respiratory conditions are reminded to have their medication close by or on them as a precaution.
- Fire Fighters will be conducting periodic patrols of the area in the days following.
