7. PROJECT UPDATE

7.1 Bremer Bay Town Centre

Brent Bailey advised that Council adopted the Bremer Bay Town Centre Structure Plan for final approval in April 2012 and submitted it to the WAPC for final approval. A subdivision application that proposes the first retail, residential and civic lots within the Town Centre is with the WAPC for approval.

This is stage 1 of the Town Centre and will effectively create the start of the main street, a new entry roundabout for Bremer Bay and paths, landscaping and upgrading of Garnett Road.

Approval for both the Structure Plan and subdivision are expected by the end of March. Landscaping plans and detailed road &drainage design have been completed. Construction is expected to start this financial year.

8.2 Bushfire refuges, bunkers – Bremer Bay Design Coordination Group

Dr Ian Weir informed the Committee of a hypothetical project to look at developing bushfire safer places in Point Henry.

Dr Weir suggested looking at an area from Little Boat Harbour to Native Dog Beach.

The project involves;

- evaluating plants, botany and projected bushfire activity in the area
- looking at ideas on developing bushfire refuges for people to hide in during a bush fire
- also at exit routes via boats from the beach.
- combining the project with beach carnival, surf tower activities as well to provide multiple uses through the year not just for bushfires.

8.3 Water from community facilities – Bremer Bay CRC

Julie Leenhouwers expressed concerns of campers looking for water which they end up stealing it from community facilities.

Action: Brent Bailey to put through a customer service request to restrict the flow on the fish cleaning stations to stop people cleaning their boats.

8.4 Weed Management Point Henry – Bremer Bay Design Coordination Group

Dr Ian Weir requested spraying or appropriate treatment for weeds on Point Henry Peninsula.

8.5 Trail Booklet – Priscilla Broadbent
