PROJECT DETAILS

Project Description:

Upgrade of hot water systems and oval drainage project

How did you establish a need for your project?

The Jerramungup Sports Club has 9 affiliated Sporting Clubs who have contributed to a 10 year Strategic Plan for the ongoing improvement of our Sporting Facilities.

This plan is lodged with the Shire of Jerramungup and is reviewed annually by club representatives.

The Sports Club completed stage 1 of this upgrade project in 2014 where it upgraded change rooms and toilet facilities and constructed a new practice cricket wicket. To capitalize on the works undertaken to date the Sports Club is now seeking to replace the lighting, hot water systems and renew the function room amenities at the winter sports pavilion and oval.

Over the past two years as the hot water systems have come to the end of their useful life the draw on power at the football oval has caused power failures on almost a weekly basis. This has caused significant interruption to football training with the lights taking more than 20 minutes to reboot once the RCD has been switched back on. In addition is also causes inherent risks with the lights going off during training plunging the whole area into pitch black darkness. A modernisation of hot water systems will significantly reduce the power draw into the complex and remove the root causes of the power failures. In addition there will also be energy savings which can be redirected into other asset management areas of the facility.

The oval drainage project will simply involve the spreading of approximately 20mm of well drained yellow sand in order to improve surface drainage and turf growth. The turf condition of the oval has deteriorated after rainfall events to the point where fixture games were almost cancelled due to the unsafe nature of the oval. A trial was done on the hockey pitch adjacent to the football oval last year with 20mm of sand spread. This resulted in less surface water on the pitch and a much firmer and trafficable pitch. The inherent danger of a boggy oval occurs when the oval dries out leaving an uneven playing surface with large holes that need filling in on a weekly basis.

This project will target 90% of our local community demographic to include families and youths.

The combined sporting group membership belongs to the Ongerup Football, Netball and Hockey Associations as well as the Eastern Great Southern Cricket Association. These Associations represent surrounding communities including, Ongerup, Gnowangerup, Lake Grace/Pingrup, Newdegate, Borden, Green Range, Wellstead, Bremer Bay, Gairdner and Boxwood Hill with an estimated 1400 people passing through the facilities on an annual basis. When Jerramungup host finals these numbers increase by an estimated 800-1,000 people. The improved facilities will benefit all of these people when utilising these facilities.
