6.4 **Digital Television**

In resolving to switch off the existing analogue services, Council has advised the Federal Government of the community's eligibility to receive financial assistance under the Satellite Subsidy Scheme to provide residents with access to the VAST Service.

7.1 **Raven Cull – FOWEG**

FOWEG is seeking help from the Shire to find out who is legally responsible for the massively disturbed planted area and to assist us in applying for compensation to revegetate the site again.

Graham Edwards advised that the revegetation of the site will be addressed in the subdivision clearance process.

7.5 ANZAC Dawn Service

Corrine Hobbs requested the Shire advertise to close Cuneo Drive for a short period of time to facilitate traffic management at this year's ANZAC Day Dawn Service.
