Yes, it was from my perspective too.

Regarding Bremer Bay Caravan Park, some of my staff have been in discussions with them about their options for accessing groundwater from near the Bremer Bay Sports Club. As you are probably aware they would require a licence from us to do that and we would need to receive a licence application from them so that we could assess it.

Having said that, and in response to your question about taking pressure off the Water Corp reticulated town water supply, we encourage outcomes like this where water is sourced that is 'fit for purpose' rather than utilising scarce potable drinking water supplies for irrigation of public open space, parks and playing fields etc.
