6. PROJECT UPDATE

6.1 Bremer Bay Town Centre

Bill Parker advised the committee that the Structure Plan documents had been forwarded to the Planning Commission for endorsement. Landcorp had commenced the initial stages of detailed design and was seeking the Shire's input in terms of drainage and the provision of services to the site.

The Shire has attended meetings with various Government Departments to secure land so that the Main Street could continue to Mary Street.

Construction is expected to commence in late 2012/early 2013.

6.2 National Park Projects

The project is essentially complete with funding now exhausted. Various committee members indicated that DEC had confirmed infestations of Phytophthora Dieback within the Fitzgerald River National Park or surrounds. DEC has requested to attend the June 2012 Council Meeting to discuss this matter further.

6.3 Paperbarks

The Shire has received a draft concept plan for Paperbarks Park in response to various water and traffic management issues. The concept plan will be presented to Council in June 2012 and presented to this committee at the next meeting.
