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Introduction

The Study

In March-April 2019, 11 Councils within the Great Southern Region administered a MARKYT® Community Scorecard to evaluate community priorities and measure individual Council performance against key indicators in each Council's Strategic Community Plan.


Scorecards invitations were posted or emailed to randomly selected households in the City of Albany and Shire of Denmark and to all households and PO Boxes in all other council areas using Australia Post unaddressed mail services.

Councils supported the study with promotions through their communication channels. All residents were invited to complete a scorecard.

In total, **2,497 respondents** submitted a response; potentially representing 12% of households across the region.

Of these respondents, 181 were council-affiliated and 2,316 were non-council affiliated. As analysis of responses from the two sample groups showed significant differences in results, the main body of the report presents responses from non-council affiliated respondents only.

The final dataset was weighted by age, gender and LGA area to match the ABS Census population profile of the region. Data has been analysed using SPSS. Where sub-totals add to ±1% of the parts, this is due to rounding errors to zero decimal places.



LOTE = Language other than English NB: when responses do not add to 100% this is due to non-responses (not shown)

Overall Performance | industry comparisons

The 'Overall Performance Index Score' is a combined measure of 'place to live' and 'governing organisation' across participating councils. The Great Southern Region's overall performance index score is 66 out of 100, 1 index point above the industry standard for Western Australia. The highest score across the Great Southern Region was 74.




How to read the MARKYT Benchmark Matrix TM

The MARKYT® Benchmark Matrix TM (shown in detail overleaf) illustrates how the community rates performance on individual measures, compared to how other councils are being rated by their communities.

There are two dimensions. The vertical axis maps community perceptions of performance for individual measures relative to the average score for all measures. The horizontal axis maps performance relative to the MARKYT® Industry Standards.


This line represents region's average performance for all individual measures.


MARKYT Community Priorities Window TM

In the Great Southern Region's Community Priorities Window, detailed overleaf, most services are ideally located in Window B. They are receiving average ratings between okay and good.


Perceived strengths include sport and recreation facilities, and library and information services.








Likelihood of recommending the Shire/City as a place to live










Online surveys are the most popular channel for consultation within the region. Albany, Cranbrook, Gnowangerup and Jerramungup residents prefer this over other options.

Postal surveys are the second most popular channel within the region, with Broomehill-Tambellup, Katanning and Plantagenet residents preferring this channel.

Broomehill-Tambellup and Plantagenet residents also prefer **speaking with a staff member or councillor**, along with Woodanilling residents, while **public meetings** are more popular in Kent and Kojonup.




Preferred sources of information

Community newspapers are the most popular source of information within the region. Broomehill-Tambellup, Cranbrook, Gnowangerup, Kojonup and Plantagenet residents prefer this over other options.

Printed shire newsletters are the second most popular source of information within the region. However Katanning was the only area in which this was the most popular source, with **e-newletters** being more popular among Jerramungup, Kent and Woodanilling residents.
